ATPIO's Teleconference of Board Members 4th May, 2007

1. In view of GMU's problems as website host, Ram Pendyala was approached by Chandra Bhat, and has agreed to start work on the site to enable membership fee payment through paypal. He indicated that this may be available within a week or so. We have agreed that we will pay ASU whatever fees from our treasury. Mohan will send the check for the amount to Ram, whenever the bill is sent.

2. We discussed the request for registration fees, supporting three IIT Delhi graduates of computer science who together with another fellow student won the best paper award submitted fro TRANSED conference in Montreal, June 16-22, 2007. We have agreed that we will send \$300.00 directly to the TRANSED 2007 organizers if the students can find other sources of funds for the remaining \$450 for the registration fee.

Ling Suen the liaison person between the foreign delegates and TRANSED organizers can be contacted by Mohan to instruct that the check can only be cashed towards registration fees only.

3. I informed every one that Sunil has contacted me to let me know that he is returning to India next week but would be willing to continue working with the committee.
